


### **Drawing Guide**

The next pages will show you how to draw numbers and the UPPERCASE and lowercase letters. Some letters can be drawn without lifting up your pen. Look for the numbered yellow marker and the word, "start", near the start of the dotted line inside the letter you want to draw. Put your pen on the coloured starting dot, and follow the dotted line in the direction of the arrow until it comes to an end. When a letter or number has a few parts, we have used numbered markers and different coloured lines to show each part. In the letter "H" below, you draw 3 lines: 1. yellow, 2. grey and 3. green. When you finish each line, you lift up your pen and start at the next numbered marker. Place your pen on the matching coloured dot as shown, and follow the direction of the arrow. When there is more than one line, like "H", be sure to join the lines.







